1	Water from a Rock	Exodus 17:1-7 The Israelites wandered in the wilderness and needed food and water. They complained, and through Moses striking a rock, God provided water.	God supplies our needs.	Psalms 63:1 O God, you are my God, I seek you, my soul thirsts for you; my flesh faints for you, as in a dry and weary land where there is no water.
2	A Healing River	2 Kings 5:1-19 A sick man obeyed God and immersed himself in the Jordan River to heal his illness. Both Naaman's body and heart were healed.	God changes our hearts.	Psalms 51:10 Create in me a clean heart, O God, and put a new and right spirit within me.
3	A Storm at Sea	Mark 4:35-41 Jesus and the disciples encountered a storm as they crossed a sea. The disciples are scared, but Jesus commanded the storm to end. The disciples wondered who Jesus is that the storm obeyed him.	God is with us.	Isaiah 43:2a When you pass through the waters, I will be with you.
4	Baptism at the River	Matthew 3:1-6, 13-17 John baptized people who confessed their sins. Jesus asked to be baptized to show his commitment as he began ministry.	God calls us to commitment.	Psalms 37:5 Commit your way to the Lord; trust in him, and he will act.
5	Living Water	John 4:1-15, 28-30 Jesus talked with a Samaritan woman about living water. She told others about Jesus and the living water he offered.	God gives us living water to share.	John 7:38b Out of the believer's heart shall flow rivers of living water.



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
